Current situation regarding Inclusion in your country

a) which is the understanding/definition of Inclusion in your environment (social and political)?

Inclusion is a process of identifying the excluded, marginalized and those who have been violated their rights. After identification and working together with them in their integration or grouping according to your desire of a group or restoration of rights violated.

b) who are in your country included and excluded youth?

There are several groups of young people who have been exluidos or self-excluded, one of the largest groups is the group of native indigenous youth, for several reasons: to have a different worldview, speak another language and not speak Spanish correctly and Location geographical does not allow them access to all government services.

c) which are the social groups that have a stronger need for Inclusion in your area? Why are them in this situation?

Teen, young, elderly, disabled and those in poverty and vulnerability as refugees or immigrants. In each case is different for youth and adolescents can talk about a search for identity and position in society. In the case of people with disabilities is still a taboo to have a family member with a disability and is worse in the countryside, because there do not have any special education institution.

d) What is done for social inclusion in your country?

Through government programs have been established policies, regulations, strategies, programs and services for care during the life cycle, special protection, universal non-contributory insurance, social mobility and economic inclusion of priority groups (children, adolescents, youth, elderly, disabled) and those who are in poverty and vulnerability.

Ensuring policies, plans, programs and projects related to cash transfers, networking discount, credit, Funeral services, retirement pension and assistance to meet contingencies heads of households, the elderly and people with disabilities; through appropriate monitoring and control of services provided to citizens.
